

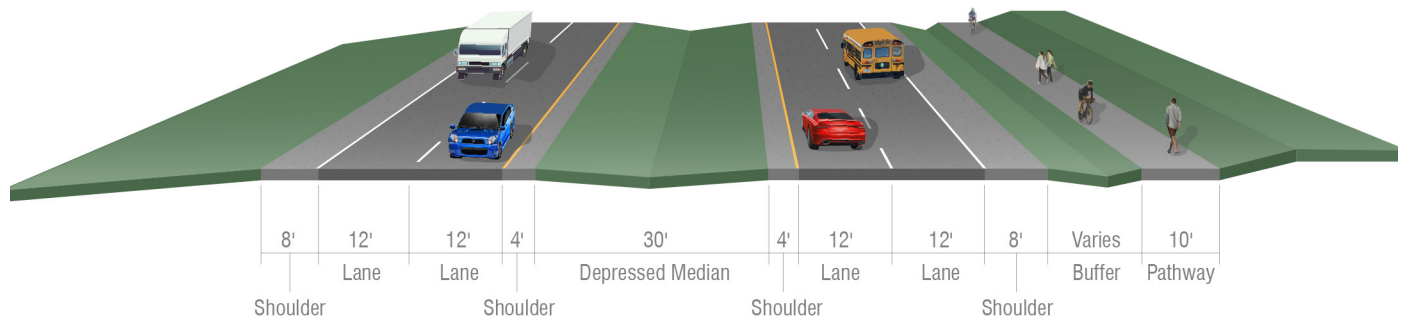

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

DOT&PF is developing two projects to reconstruct Knik-Goose Bay (KGB) Road between Centaur Avenue and Settlers Bay Drive. KGB Road has congestion, poor performance, and high collision rates. This effort will expand the corridor to a four-lane, divided roadway with a separated multi-use pathway on the north side that will allow KGB Road to function more efficiently with fewer delays, more capacity, fewer crashes, and increased safety.

## DESIGN UPDATE

This is a high priority project for DOT&PF. Construction of Phase 1 (Centaur Avenue to Fairview Loop) started in Fall 2022. Project design for Phase 2 (Fairview Loop to Settlers Bay Drive) is anticipated to be complete in 2026. Right-of-way will be cleared within the project limits for improvements.

## RIGHT-OF-WAY

DOT&PF Right-of-Way staff have worked closely with property owners on acquisitions in the four-mile segment between Centaur Avenue and Fairview Loop. All the property acquisitions for Phase 1 are complete, and acquisitions for Phase 2 are anticipated to be complete in 2026. Staff will be contacting impacted property owners starting in late 2023 and early 2024 for Phase 2.

## UTILITY COORDINATION

Due to the significant amount of utility relocation required in the corridor, DOT&PF has worked closely with representatives from GCI, MTA, MEA, ENSTAR, and the City of Wasilla on utility designs. Utility relocations for Phase 1 are underway, and Phase 2 agreements are anticipated to be complete in 2026.

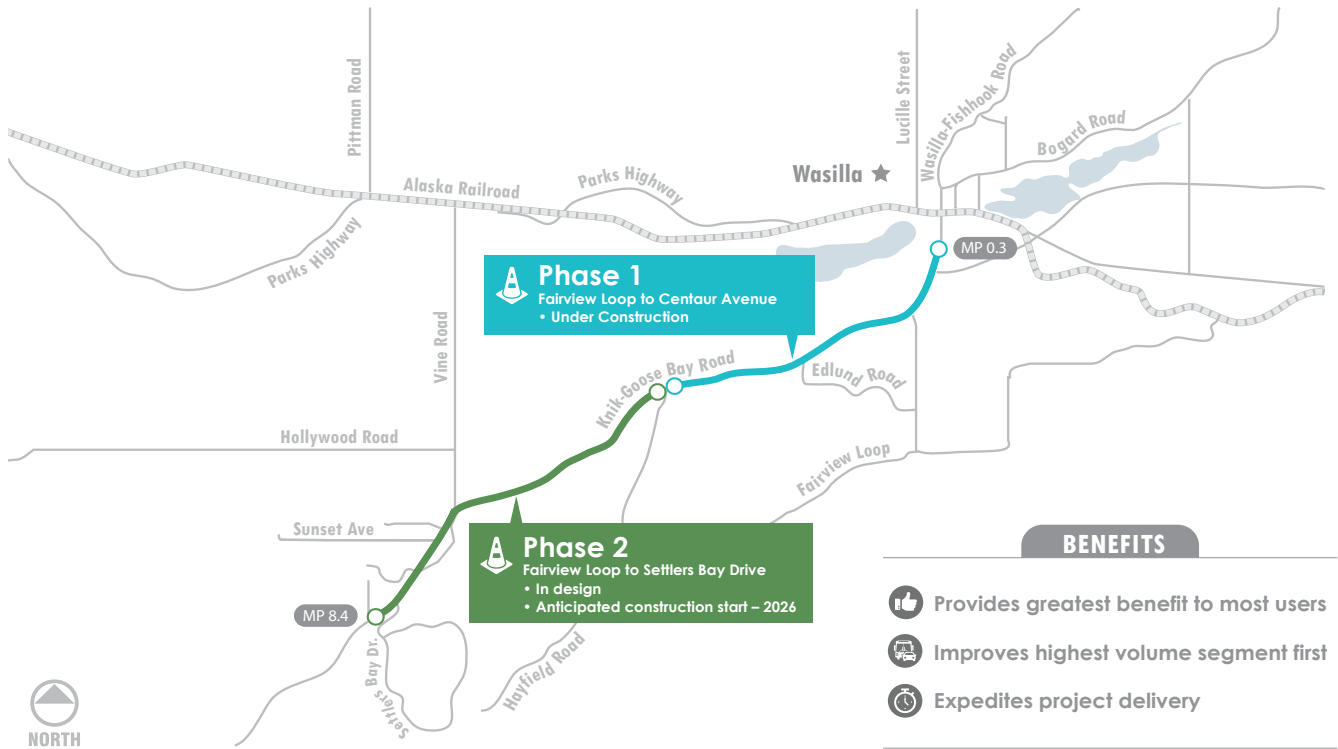

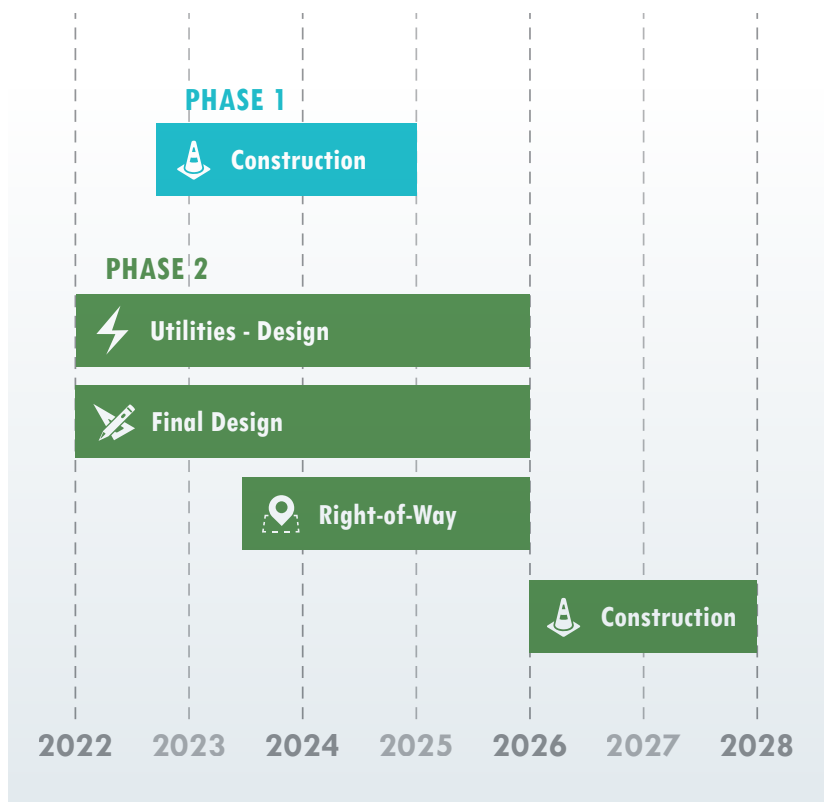
Figure 2: Construction Phasing Plan



## CONSTRUCTION PHASING & PROJECT TIMELINE

To expedite delivery and minimize inconvenience to the traveling public, businesses, and residents, construction of the two projects will be phased over several seasons, as shown in Figures 2 and 3. Phase 1 construction, from Centaur Avenue to Fairview Loop, is now under construction. Phase 2 construction, from Fairview Loop to Settlers Bay Drive, is anticipated to start in 2026.
